Discussion

2024/2025 annual prices

- ACT Government guest speakers Rachael de Hosson, Executive Branch Manager for Net Zero Energy Transformation and James Priestley, Senior Director of Integrated Energy Plan Deliver provided information on the Large-scale feed-in tariff (LFiT).
- Megan Wilcox, General Manager of Economic Regulation provided context as to how LFiT, as well as other factors, impacts electricity network prices for 2024/25.
- An update on gas prices for 2024/25 was also provided.

Overview of key challenge for our gas five-year plan

- Megan Wilcox discussed challenges such as uncertain future gas demand and fair cost distribution among network users as we plan for our gas network five-year plan (GN26) and broader energy transition.
- Discussed overarching regulatory approach for networks to recover allowed revenue through revenue cap and price cap tariff mechanisms.
- Discussed tariff structures and the need to re-engage to ensure they reflect network costs, customer ability to respond to price signals, and impact on emissions reductions amidst the future direction of the gas network.
